What you need to know

What qualification can I earn?

You will receive an internationally recognised qualification from a triple-accredited, global business school. If you complete Stage 1 only, you will achieve the Henley Postgraduate Certificate in Leadership, if you pass Stages 1 and 2 only you will receive the Henley Postgraduate Diploma in Leadership, and if you complete all three stages you will attain the Henley MA Leadership.

How long does it last?

The programme is made up of three stages and takes 21 months in total.

Can I learn alongside my current role?

The MA Leadership is flexible and part-time, so our students can combine study with their career.

How is it delivered?


Intensive, face-to-face workshops – which are supported by a comprehensive, virtual learning environment – allow participants to immediately apply what they have learnt in the workplace.

Module 1: Leadership concepts

Develop your understanding of leadership theories, including the management of individuals, teams and organisations. Improve your ability to:

- Engage with leadership practices based on relevant thinking
- Take a critical and analytical approach to leadership thinking and practice
- Understand and apply leadership strategies, tools and practices from a variety of perspectives.

Module 2: Personal leadership development

Enhance your personal leadership skills, and your ability to:

- Be self-aware
- Plan, manage and reflect on your personal leadership style
- Develop your behavioural skills to increase the effectiveness of your leadership
- Explore the ethical and practical issues in leadership.

Exemptions

1. Holders of other Henley qualifications may be eligible for exemption from the Stage 1 elective. More details available on request.

2. If you have significant prior leadership experience or have previously attended another high-level development programme, instead of doing a Stage 1 elective, you can produce a written summary (3,000 words) of your experiences for assessment. More details available on request.

First elective

You can study two electives as part of the MA programme – one in Stage 1 and one in Stage 2.

This gives you an opportunity to explore topics of interest to you.

Elective modules may include:

- Leadership of complexity and change
- Project and programme leadership
- Mobilising & maintaining organisational energy
- Coaching and mentoring for leaders
- Facilitation for leaders
- Neuroscience of leadership coaching
- Digital technology leadership.

Leadership of the team

Stage 2: The Henley Postgraduate Diploma in Leadership

Stage 2 typically takes seven months, including seven days of residential workshops. Assessment is from two 3,000 word assignments and one 5,000 word assignment.

- Plan, manage and reflect on your practical leadership
- Manage your behavioural skills
- Be self-aware
- Consider the risks and practical issues in relation to leadership.

Leadership in the organisation

Stage 3: The Henley MA Leadership

Stage 3 typically takes seven months, including six days of residential workshops. Assessment is made up of one 5,000 word assignment, one 3,000 word learning reflections piece, and a 12,000 word study/dissertation.

Module 1: Developing leadership in others

This module helps you to develop leadership in others. With this end in mind, you will:

- Plan, manage and reflect on your individual personal leadership
- Develop your behavioural skills
- Consider how to develop future leaders
- Improve your awareness of ethical, moral and practical issues.

Module 2: Leadership study/dissertation

The leadership study/dissertation is a major research-based project in which you investigate a significant business problem, and recommend solutions. It will develop and build on key elements of your learning throughout the programme, and you will apply it within a practical context. Programme members normally choose a challenge in their own organisation or industry as a basis for their leadership study project.
